Booking Conditions

Prior bookings are required for all accommodation, including unpowered camping. A deposit is required to secure your booking.

IT IS A REQUIREMENT FOR ALL GUESTS TO CHECK INTO THE KIOSK UPON ARRIVAL TO COLLECT THEIR PARK PERMIT OR KEYS.

Cancellation Policy

- 0 - 7 Days Notice (No refund)
- 8 + Days Notice (Full refund)
- No Refund for early departures or no shows

Please Note: Cleaning fees will apply if accommodation is vacated and left in an unacceptable manner. Damages and breakages will be charged to the person whose name is against the booking.

Information and Guidelines

Please take the time to read the following information. Your cooperation in observing these rules will be greatly appreciated and will ensure that everyone has a relaxing, safe and enjoyable stay.

Amenities

Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and must not be allowed to play in or around the amenities block. Please keep shower times to a minimum, both for water usage and waiting times for other campers. No hot water to be taken from the amenities blocks (hot water is available from the Camp Kitchen).

Camp Fires

Camp fires are permitted in some areas unless fire bans are in place. Please keep to a sensible size and in a contained area. Keep away from trees and put out properly when not in use - safety is a priority. Do not burn rubbish, glass or metal items in fires. Firewood is available. Chainsaws are not permitted in the park.

Camp Kitchen

Facility is available for all campers - please clean after each use.

Drone

If operating a drone, please ensure to follow Australia's Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) rules & regulations. Drones must be at least 30 metres from people at all times.

Dump Points

Please empty 'Grey' and 'Black' water to designated dump points only.

Evacuation

In case of fire or other emergency, please make your way to the evacuation assembly point as shown on the map.

Feeding

Feeding of native animals is not permitted.

Fees

Fees must be paid in full prior to setting up camp or accessing accommodation.

Fishing

Boondooma Dam is well stocked with Australian Bass, Yellow Belly and Silver Perch. Fishing Permits are required and available online (discounts apply for yearly permits for pensioners) - take note of legal sizes and bag limits.

Garbage

Garbage is to be placed in the skip bins provided.

Generators

Generators are allowed from 7am to 9pm. Cooperation in strictly observing these times is required as a courtesy to fellow campers.

Kiosk

The Kiosk has a range of convenience items including bread, groceries, icecreams, fishing tackle, lures, bait, souvenirs, gas, ice and more.

Laundry

Washing machines and dryers are available for use by all campers. Machines require \$1 & \$2 coins, \$5 per cycle.

Maintenance

Work on vehicles or boats is not permitted anywhere in the park.

Noise

To ensure all campers enjoy their stay, please keep noise to a minimum, particularly after 9:30pm.

Pets

Pets are welcome in the Park. Owners are required to control their pets at all times (on a leash) and clean up after them. Pets are not allowed inside or around Cabins/Villas/Bunk House complex/ Amenities Blocks or in any other buildings.

Security Advice

Ensure all property & vehicles are locked & secure. Valuables should be kept in a safe place.

Speed

The speed limit is strictly 20km per hour (as sign posted) throughout the park. Slow down around children and wildlife. All road rules must be complied with.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited inside all buildings at the camping and recreation area.

Visitors

A charge is made on extra persons staying overnight and campers are responsible for booking their visitors in on arrival.

Water Activities

Water activities are enjoyed by boaties, skiers, paddlers and swimmers - please obey all water safety rules! Information and brochures can be obtained from the Kiosk.
